# 3 Core Components of GxP



## **Traceability**

**Record sufficient information** to recreate processes.



#### **Accountability**

Maintain records to identify who participated in a process.



#### **Data Integrity**

Secure data and follow the ALCOA rule.

# 5 P's of GxP

A useful framework to implement traceability and accountability standards is known as the "5 P's" of GxP. These refer to:



## **People**

Training, hygiene, reporting and review systems.

#### **Procedures** SOP's established,

accessible and reviewed regularly.





#### **Products & Primary (Raw) Materials**

Training, hygiene, reporting and review systems.

## Premises & Equipment

Clean facilities, monitoring, safety processes, validation and calibration.





## **Processes**

Overall process documented clearly, validated regularly and followed consistently.
